Part A - Explanatory notes pursuant to Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard 134 ("MFRS 134") Interim Financial Reporting

## A1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of MFRS134: Interim Financial Reporting and Rule 9.22 and Appendix 9B of the ACE Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") ("ACE LR").

## A2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation applied in the unaudited condensed interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted as disclosed in the Group's annual audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2015.

The Group has adopted the new and revised Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRSs"), amendments to published standards and IC Interpretations that became mandatory for the current reporting period. The adoption of these new and revised MFRSs, amendments to published standards and IC Interpretations does not result in significant changes in the accounting policies of the Group.

## A3. AUDITORS REPORT ON PRECEDING ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

There was no audit qualification on the annual financial statements of JAG for the financial year ended 31 December 2015.

## A4. SEASONAL AND CYCLICAL FACTORS

The Group's business operations were mainly attributable (i.e., contributing approximately 98% of its total revenue) from its manufacturing and trading segments involving recycling and recovery activities and are affected by the cyclicality of the semiconductor companies. The semiconductor industry is cyclical and dependent on its end user industries, in particular the electrical & electronic industries. The demand for semiconductors typically mirrors the trend in the demand for personal computers, mobile phones and other electronic equipment.

As the availability of electrical and electronic waste ("E-waste") for recycling and manufacturing services is dependent on the volume of E-waste discharged by semiconductor manufacturers, the E-waste recycling industry is dependent on the trends in the semiconductor industry.

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows during the financial quarter and year under review.

The extraordinary general meeting for the shareholders of JAG to approve the Proposed Diversification will be held on 3 March 2017.

On 7 February 2017, the Company announced to seek its shareholders' approval for the Company to purchase its own ordinary shares up to 10% of the total number of issued shares of the Company ("Proposed Share Buy-Back")

Save as disclosed above and in Note B6, there were no other material events subsequent to the current financial quarter ended 31 December 2016 up to the date of this report.

Part B - Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Securities for the ACE Market

## **B1. REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE**

The Group recorded revenue of approximately RM21.50 million for the current financial quarter and RM82.91 million for the financial year ended 31 December 2016, respectively. Export sales accounted for about RM17.43 million and RM63.33 million or 81.06% and 76.38% of total revenue for the current financial quarter and current financial year ended 31 December 2016 respectively.

The Group's revenue comprised mainly the sales of recovered metals such a copper, tin, iron, silver, gold, aluminium and nickel. The lower revenue for the current financial quarter was mainly due to lower sales of copper and gold. The lower sales of copper was attributed to lower sales volume and lower average copper price while lower sales of gold was attributed to lower sales volume although the average gold price was higher. The lower revenue for the current financial year was mainly due to lower sales of copper arising from lower sales volume and lower average copper price.

Other income for the current financial year mainly consisted of fixed deposit interest income, gain on foreign exchange and gain on disposal of quoted securities. The higher other income for the previous financial year was mainly due to net fair value gains on held for trading investments, gain on unrealized foreign exchange and gain on disposal of quoted securities.

The Group reported a profit after tax of RM2.40 million and RM2.06 million for the current financial quarter and current financial year, respectively. The Group's improved performance was mainly attributable to higher average commodity prices for gold, iron and silver.

The Group's staff cost was lower for the current financial year mainly due to the absence of staff cost for SIS as there were no SIS options granted to staff, over recognition of SIS options expenses and lower headcount.

Other operating expenses mainly consisted of manufacturing overhead expenses, loss on foreign exchange, professional fees, utilities expenses, procurement fees, entertainment and travelling expenses and allowance for doubtful debts. The decrease in other operating expenses for the current financial year compared to the previous financial year was mainly due to lower manufacturing overhead expenses and lower allowance for doubtful debts being provided in the current financial year.

# B2. COMPARISON OF CURRENT FINANCIAL QUARTER RESULTS WITH THE PRECEDING QUARTER

The Group recorded revenue of approximately RM21.50 million and RM23.35 million for the current financial quarter ended 31 December 2016 and preceding financial quarter ended 30 September 2016 respectively. The decrease in revenue was mainly due to lower sales of gold.

# B2. COMPARISON OF CURRENT FINANCIAL QUARTER RESULTS WITH THE PRECEDING QUARTER (CONTINUED)

The increase of other income was mainly due to unrealized gain on foreign exchange during the current financial quarter compared to preceding quarter resulting from the appreciation of USD against RM.

The Group incurred higher other operating expenses in the current quarter mainly due to allowance for doubtful debts had been provided, unrealized loss on the quoted securities and realized losses on foreign exchange as well as higher procurement fees, higher rental expenses, and higher Goods and Services Tax ("GST") expenses incurred by non-GST registrant subsidiaries.

The Group recorded profit after tax for the current financial quarter mainly due to higher average commodity prices mainly for copper, iron and nickel for the current quarter.

## **B3. PROSPECTS FOR FOLLOWING FINANCIAL YEAR**

Fluctuations in exchange rates and commodity prices will continue to be a challenge to the Group notwithstanding the Group's financial performance improved in the financial year ended 31 December 2016. However, the Directors remain positive on the Group's prospects.

In addition, the Board expects the Proposed Diversification to contribute positively to the Group's performance in the coming financial years. JAG Land Sdn Bhd ("JAG Land") is in the midst of exploring with other parties for JAG Land to acquire more lands and/or to undertake other property development projects via joint ventures, the details of which have yet to be determined at this juncture. Once the details have been finalised and upon signing any definite agreement, the Company will make the appropriate announcement(s) in due course pursuant to the ACE LR, if required.

The Proposed Diversification is consequential to the proposed mixed development on the Land (as defined in Note B6) which comprise the development of shop-offices, office suites and residential apartments ("Proposed Development Project"). The Proposed Diversification is in line with the Group's plan to diversify its sources of revenue and earnings and to reduce the Group's reliance on its recycling business. The proposed development project is expected to contribute gross development profit of between RM20 million to RM35 million to be achieved progressively over the development period of the Proposed Development Project and the sales of the shop-offices, office suites and residential apartments.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Board is of the opinion that the prospects for the financial year ending 31 December 2017 will be favorable.

## B4. VARIANCE OF FORECAST PROFIT AND PROFIT GUARANTEE

The Group has not provided any profit forecast or profit guarantee and thus this is not applicable to the Group.

The effective tax rate of the Group for current quarter and financial year ended 31 December 2016 are lower than the statutory tax rate of 24% due to business losses allowance carried forward and availability of reinvestment allowance which arose from the capital expenditure of a subsidiary in the current financial quarter under review and previous financial year.

## **B6.** STATUS OF CORPORATE PROPOSALS

The Board announced that JAG Land had on 28 January 2016, entered into a Sale and Purchase Agreement with Chewway Heavy Machinery Sdn. Bhd., for the purpose of purchasing a parcel of freehold land ("Land") held under H.S. (D) 137367, PT 133653, Mukim Klang, District of Klang, State of Selangor measuring approximately 13,489.5 square meters in an area bearing postal address Lot No. 10428, Jalan Sg Jati/KS7, Kg Jawa, 41000 Klang, Selangor Darul Ehsan for a total purchase consideration of RM9,873,668.00 ("Proposed Acquisition of Land"). On 3 August 2016, the Board announced that the Company has received confirmation in writing from the solicitors of JAG Land to confirm that the Proposed Acquisition of Land has been fully completed on the same date.

On 4 March 2016, TA Securities had on behalf of the Board announced that the Company proposes to undertake the proposed private placement of new ordinary shares in JAG, representing not more than ten percent (10%) of the total number of issued shares of JAG (excluding treasury shares, if any) ("Proposed Private Placement"). The listing application for the Proposed Private Placement has been submitted to Bursa Securities on 16 March 2016.

The Company had on 22 March 2016 obtained Bursa Securities' approval for the listing and quotation of up to 153,844,000 Placement Shares to be issued pursuant to the Proposed Private Placement. The approval granted by Bursa Securities for the Proposed Private Placement, is subjected to the following conditions:

- JAG and TA Securities must fully comply with the relevant provisions under the ACE LR
  pertaining to the implementation of the Proposed Private Placement;

# **B6.** STATUS OF CORPORATE PROPOSALS (CONTINUED)

JAG is required to ensure full compliance of all the requirements pertaining to the Proposed Private Placement as provided under the ACE LR at all times. On 2 September 2016, TA Securities had on behalf of the Board announced the revision of utilization of proceeds from the Proposed Private Placement.

On 6 September 2016, the Company submitted an application to Bursa Securities for an extension of time of approximately six (6) months (i.e., from 22 September 2016 until 21 March 2017) to complete the implementation of the Proposed Private Placement ("Extension of Time"). On 13 September 2016, TA Securities on behalf of the Board announced that Bursa Securities has, vide its letter dated 9 September 2016 granted the Company the Extension of Time.

As at the date of this announcement, the Proposed Private Placement is still pending implementation and completion.

On 3 January 2017, TA Securities had on behalf of the Board announced that the Company proposes to undertake a Proposed Diversification. The extraordinary general meeting for the shareholders of JAG to approve the Proposed Diversification will be held on 3 March 2017

On 7 February 2017, the Company announced that it proposes to seek shareholders' approval for the Company to undertake the Proposed Share Buy-Back.
